

For devolo, this meant finding a project management solution that could be a single source for information and resources, provide increased transparency across teams, and limit maintenance to the IT team.



Collaborative social feeds

Utilize dedicated Yammer newsfeeds in SharePoint to communicate with colleagues in real-time on project details.

For 13 years, devolo had operated on Project Server 2003 with remarkable success. But maintaining the server was a time-consuming task for the project management department. They needed a solution that could streamline their organizational communication even further and transfer the maintenance responsibilities to the right team, all while staggering the migration so that projects wouldn't be interrupted midstream by the adoption of new software.

Microsoft Project Online was the top contender because it could interoperate with projects still being managed by Project Server 2003.

Solution

The benefits were there from the start. devolo worked with Bechtle AG, a member of the Microsoft partner network, to help with the migration. While adopting the new Project Online software, devolo was able to stagger the migration and continue running pre-existing projects on the old system. This meant a quick and seamless migration, with zero downtime.

The move to the cloud has also kept the system current with the latest tools, features, and updates. This means that the IT team—and project managers—don't have to worry about time-consuming upgrades, freeing them up to work on more value-added activities.

Bechtle AG and devolo are working on some additional customization that will improve communication across departments—and, with it, project planning. This new interface will provide added insight into employee holidays, ultimately helping to simplify resource planning.

Project Online also integrates with Microsoft SQL Server Reporting Services. Using this integration capability, Bechtle AG and devolo are developing a feature that consolidates data from the financial, project management, and product databases. The effects are expected to be two-fold: teams will have a single source for all documentation, improving visibility between departments. And reporting will become easier and more customized. "Our project managers have to report on KPIs and product development status to management, so if we merge existing data that is related to each project, we can create views and reports much more

easily than our current method, which involves manually building Excel spreadsheets," says Nöthen. "This would not be possible if we were still running an on-premises solution."

devolo currently manages approximately 20 projects through Project Online. That's expected to reach more than 60 active projects within 12 months.






Use one of the built-in, customizable reports—like Burndown and Resource Overview—to gain insights, communicate information to stakeholders, and achieve results.

Real-time communications

Integrated communication tools like Skype for Business enable project team members to collaborate using voice, video, or chat from within Project, so there's no need to switch between apps.

Greater visibility

Project integrates with Microsoft Office 365 tools like SharePoint and OneDrive for Business, so you can allow your teams to share project calendars and task updates, send task notifications via email, and store project files where other team members are able to access them.
